## *Co-operative Classes A, B & C*

These exhibits require a minimum of 2 members to contribute items. Marks are awarded for the interpretation of the title and the staging in addition to those earned for the quality of each individual exhibit within it. Variety of techniques, visual impact, use of colour and creativity are, therefore, valuable in terms of points.

Flower arrangements will be classed as a **CRAFT** item and only one arrangement will be allowed in a class.

**ONLY ONE EXHIBIT per WI. IS ALLOWED in a CO-OPERATIVE CLASS**

### *Class A1 "Time to Celebrate"*

**Exhibit to depict the title  
6 items to be judged which must include  
1 craft item, 1 Produce item  
plus 4 other items**

To be staged, freestanding from ground level, **WITHIN** an area 4ft x 4ft (122cm x 122cm) with height unlimited

Any base to be provided by the exhibiting WI.

**TO BE VIEWED FROM THE FRONT**

### *Class A2 "Home and Country"*

**3 items of craft, and 3 items of Produce**

To be staged on a round table 3 ft in diameter (91.5 cm) standing 30" (76cm) high.

Tables will be provided but must be skirted by the exhibitor, **with only the skirting to hang over the edge of the table.**

**TO BE VIEWED FROM ALL ROUND**

## **RULES FOR ALL CLASSES**

1. Entry is restricted to members of Cumbria - Westmorland Federation
2. Individual entries are unlimited unless stated otherwise.
3. All work entered must be the member's own work.
4. **Craft work** must have been completed within the last two years and must not have been worn. Neither must it have been exhibited before at the Westmorland County Show.  
**No two items of the same design may be entered by an exhibitor.**

5. Entries will be judged in accordance with the WI show guidance book "**On With the Show**".  
The judges decision will be final.  
**Any complaints must be made in writing to the WI Office.**

6. Every exhibit will be individually marked out of 20 and given the relevant star.

<b>Gold star</b>	<b>19 - 20 points</b>
<b>Silver star</b>	<b>17 - 18 points</b>
<b>Red star</b>	<b>15 - 16 points</b>
<b>Blue star</b>	<b>13 - 14 points</b>
<b>Green star</b>	<b>11 - 12 points</b>

Points will be accumulated towards cups and trophies.  
Any exhibit below standard will not be starred.

7. Cups and Trophies will be presented at the Annual Council Meeting in October and will remain in the recipients possession for one year.
8. The marquee will close at 5.30 PM on Show Day.  
Exhibits must be collected from the marquee between 5.45 PM and 6.15 PM at the end of the Show,  
**Or** on Friday at 9 am. (special instructions will be issued later)

**NB No movement of vehicles is allowed on the Show field before 6 PM for Health & Safety reasons .**

9. Every reasonable care will be taken to safeguard the exhibits but the committee cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage.

## CLASS G LIQUEURS & CORDIALS

- G1 Half Bottle of Liqueur (should be at least 12 months old)  
(type and date of making must be stated on label)
- G2 Bottle of Cordial, Crush or Squash (type to be stated on label)

## CLASS H HOME GROWN GARDEN PRODUCE

- H1 Container of Cut **Mixed Flowers**
- H2 Selection of named **Mixed Herbs**, shown to their best advantage
- H3 Indoor **Foliage Plant** (to be named)
- H4 Vase of three **Dahlias**.
- H5 A container of **cacti, succulents and/or alpines**.
- Pot plants must have been in the exhibitors possession for over 12 months.

**Fruit and Vegetables**, must be home grown by the exhibitor and displayed on a plate.

- H6 **Three Apples**
- H7 **Three Carrots**
- H8 **Two Courgettes**
- H9 **A Mis-shapen Vegetable**
- H10 **A truss of Tomatoes**
- H11 **Five Tomatoes**

## CLASS J FLORAL ART (CRAFT items)

Fresh plant material must predominate

*The Princess Grace Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the best Floral Art Exhibit in the Show.*

- J1 **“Celebration Centre Piece”** Floral Exhibit
- Flowers may be bought Accessories allowed  
(size not to exceed (50cm x 50cm) Height unlimited)
- J2 **“100 Shades of Green”** Floral Exhibit
- Flowers permitted and may be bought ; Accessories allowed  
size not to exceed 60cm x 60cm, height unlimited.

### Class B 3

3 items of Craft

#### *“Party Gifts”*

to be staged within an allotted space,  
2ft wide x 2ft 6inches deep (61cm x 76 cm)

Neither a back or sides are obligatory Accessories allowed

### Class B 4

3 Items of Produce

using local recipes

#### *“Party time in Cumbria Westmorland”*

to be staged within an allotted space,  
2ft wide x 2ft 6inches deep (61 cm x 76 cm)

Neither a back or sides are obligatory Accessories allowed

### Class C 5 Yeast Cookery

#### *Five varieties in a Basket.*

To be presented in the basket ready for judging

### Class C 6 Five varieties of Sweet Biscuits

(total weight not less than 8 oz)

To be presented for judging as the finished item.

**(to be displayed in a tin with a lid)**

### Class C 7

#### *A Display of Five varieties of home produced Mixed Vegetables.*

(To be exhibited in a basket or box not to exceed 36 cms overall)

## CLASS D CRAFTS

Items must be the *bona fide* work of the entrant, never been worn, and completed within the last two years. **No two items of the same design may be entered by an exhibitor.**

- D1 Applique, Patchwork, Quilting** (items professionally quilted must be declared on entry sheets and also on entry tickets. These items will be judged as patchwork)
- D2 Beadwork** A bracelet that is mounted for display.
- D3 Crochet**
- D4 Dressed Doll** (Doll may be bought)
- D5 Embroidery** (hand or machine)
- D6 Felt Work**
- D7 Lace**, (small items to be mounted)
- D8 Soft Furnishings**
- D9 Hard craft:-** Treen, ceramics, metal and glass work
- D10 A Keepsake Box**
- D11 Dressmaking**
- D12 Knitting :- 2 classes. Only two entries per person in each class.**  
**The yarn label must be attached to each item.**
- D12A. An item of knitting using 4 ply .**
- D12B. An item of knitting using double knitting yarn and a cable technique.**
- D13 Jewellery** in any medium. (small items must be boxed or mounted)
- D14 A bought Hat decorated with hand crafted flowers.** (No fascinators)
- D15 A 21st Century Craft Item**
- D16 A hand crafted Invitation card**  
Must be 75% of own craft skills.  
**Only one entry per person allowed**
- D17 A 3D Hedgehog** in any medium
- D18 Art work** (in any medium) .The art itself not to exceed 40cm x 40cm  
It may be framed and can be either mounted or unmounted.  
**Title:- "A Westmorland Landscape " ( one entry per person)**
- D19 Photography 2 classes. Only one entry per person in each class.**  
Photos to be at least 7" x 5" (16.6 cm x 12.7 cm) plus mounting.  
Mounted on card, not framed.
- D19A Title:- "Cumbrian Kaleidoscope"**
- D19B Title - "Cumbrian Wildlife."**

## CLASS E COOKERY

**Entries in classes E2, E3, E6, E7, E8 ,E12 to be displayed on a suitably shaped stiffened bases, not on plates and preferably on cake boards for safe packing and transporting.**

Preformed liners should **not** be used for any cakes.

- E1 Westmorland Dream Cake** (as in 'Treats for Tea Time').  
(4 pieces in a tray bake box)
- E2 Four Fruit Tea Cakes**
- E3 A Vegetable Cake** (approx. 20 cm tin) to be named.
- E4 Four sausage rolls** in a tray bake box.
- E5 Four Florentines** in a tray bake box
- E6 Undecorated chocolate Sandwich Cake** ( approx. 20cm tin)  
(*Mrs. Appleby trophy will be awarded for the best cake* )
- E7 My favourite Cake'** (to be named when presented.)
- E8 A Round of Shortbread**
- E9 Four pieces of Tray Bake** (with a pastry base) (named)
- E10 Four squares of Gingerbread**
- E11 Four Scones**, any variety (named)
- E12 A Gluten free** bakery item (recipe to be included with exhibit)
- E13 Jar of Lemon Curd** in 8oz jars with twist tops

Boxes for classes E1, E4, E5, E9, E10, E11 can be purchased from the WI office.

## CLASS F PRESERVES

To be exhibited in plain jars of 1 lb, 12 oz, or 8 oz in size, unless otherwise stated. **8oz jars & lids can be purchased from WI office.**

Entries in Classes F1 to F9 are limited to one per person except F4

- F1 Jar of Blackcurrant Jam**
- F2 Jar of Raspberry Jam**
- F3 Jar of Strawberry jam**
- F4 Jar of any other jam** 1 each of any variety
- F5 Jar of Marmalade**
- F6 Jar of Fruit Jelly** (in 8oz. Jars)
- F7 Jar of Herb Jelly** (in 8oz. Jars)
- F8 Jar of Cooked Chutney** (must be at least 2 months old)
- F9 Jar of Pickles**
