To be displayed in any medium.
The exhibitor to provide base & backing with no sides

Depicting the title of :-

Space allowed :-

2' 0”(61 cm) deep by 2'6”(76 cm) wide,
height unlimited– on a trestle table.

Ensure staging is securely fixed, and choose your
exhibits carefully as they must withstand three days in
the marquee.

effective portrayal of the title.**

CLASS B :- co-operative for 2 or more members
Only one entry per WI allowed

3 items of Home-made produce using **three**
different fruits and depicting

‘ Tutti Fruitti’

to be displayed **on a base** not exceeding 20” x 20” (51 x 51 cm)
(to be supplied by the entrants)

Accessories allowed

Each item and the presentation will be marked out of 10.

A polythene box must be provided for the safe keeping of
baked items overnight in the marquee.

Classes C, D, E will be judged on visual impact only

CLASS C:- CRAFT

Create a hand crafted item in any medium.

“A Shopping Bag or Basket”

Class D1:- Floral Art An Exhibit

‘Spend, Spend, Spend’

Accessories allowed 20” x 20” (50.8 x 50.8 cm) height unlimited.

CLASS D2:- Floral Art An Exhibit

“Hot and Spicy”

Accessories allowed 20” x 20” (50.8 x 50.8 cm) . Height unlimited

*The Chris Corner trophy will be awarded to the
best exhibit in the floral art classes.*

CLASS E:- “Fun Item”

“Funky Chicken”
